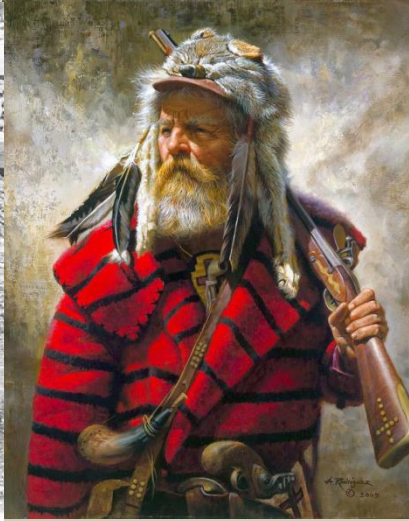
THE CONCEPT THAT I FOUND INTERESTING WAS:

The Mountain Man Unit was the unit that I found most interesting.

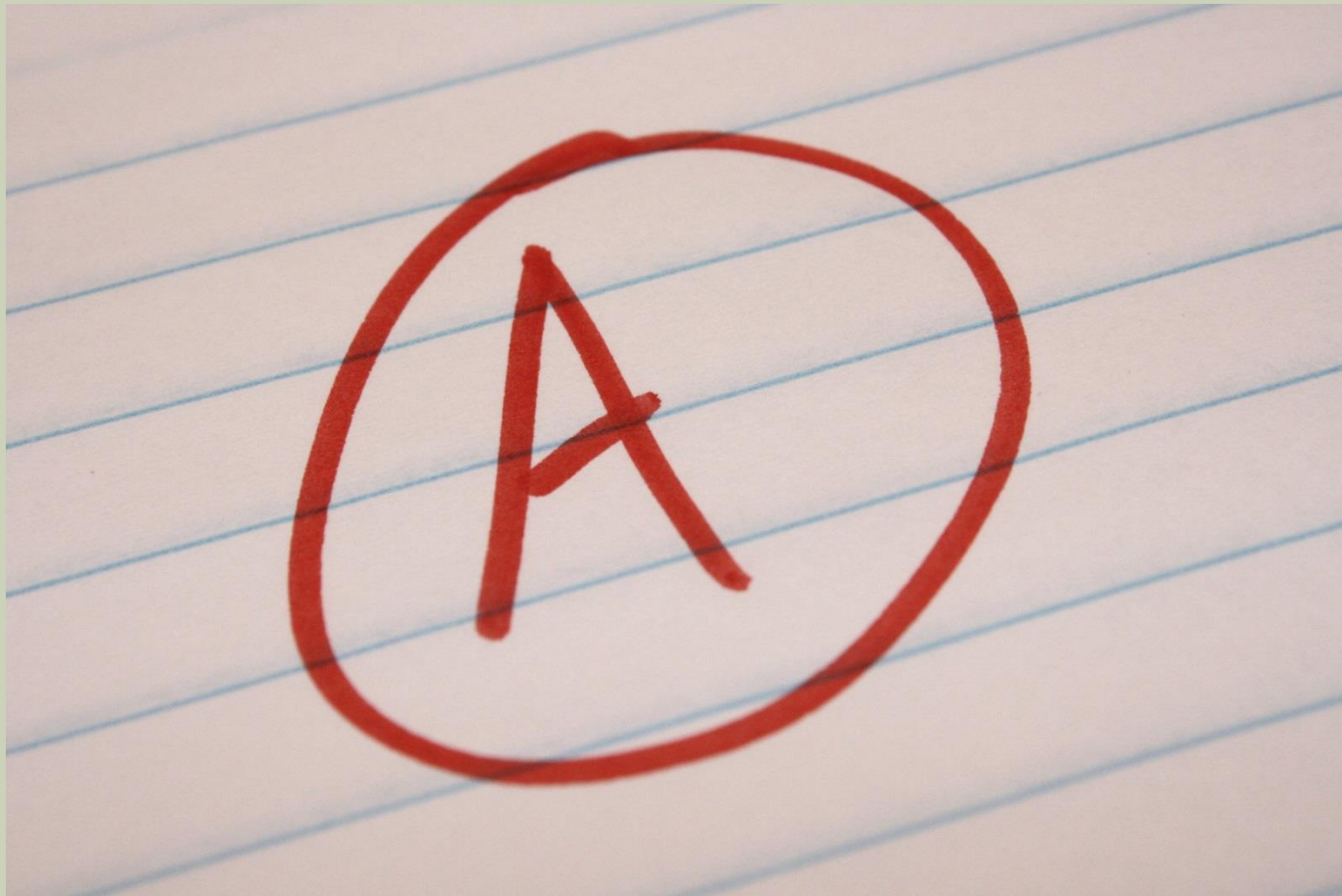


THE CONCEPT THAT I FOUND LEAST INTERESTING WAS:

Why Decided To Make My Tipi The Way I Did

I used the Tipi design of the Crow Native American tribe. The Crow Nation normally had the door facing east, into the sunrise, however, the position that the door was facing depended on the weather.

How I Made My Tipi

I made my tipi out of chokecherry branches that I whittled to take off the bark. Then, with the whittled branches, I took Elmer's glue and put it on the floor of a box that I trimmed down. To make the bottom look realistic, I sprinkled dirt on the glue and attached the tipi sticks with the strands of Paracord and a piece of a leather shoe lace, tying the sticks together to make a cone shape. Next, I sewed leather together, to represent the buffalo hide that Native Americans have sewn together while making their tipis.
